## ***How Has School Council Supported Our School This Year***

- ◆ Subsidized Junglesport for all students.
  - ◆ Pledged \$30,000 over the next 4 years to create the 'Maker's Space' in the library which will be a place for collaboration, creativity and innovation - \$4,000 this year.
  - ◆ Supported the library program 'The Forest of Reading' and purchased \$1,000 worth of books focusing on diversity and inclusivity.
  - ◆ Hosted the Halloween Dance for all students, providing glow sticks for everyone.
  - ◆ Provided supplies for various school clubs such as knitting and chess.
  - ◆ Ran a winter clothing drive which provided warm clothing to students in need.
